A look into May

→ May 14 School Council Annual General Meeting (AGM) 6:30 PM via MS TEAMS

All parents and guardians of children enrolled in a K-6 program at École Frère Antoine are automatically voting members of the SC, and are encouraged to attend the AGM, where the SC executive team (Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, and Treasurer) for the 2024-2025 year will be elected. All members are welcome to nominate themselves for a position. Under the Schools Act,the SC is an advisory body to school administration that also offers events for the children and families (such as the BBQ, dances, lunch events, and sports day), and assists where needed with in-school fundraisers such as Art Cards. Be sure to watch your email for the link!

On behalf of the School Society, the Ecole Frere Antoine Fundraising Association (EFAFA), you are also invited to stay logged for their AGM after the SC AGM is adjourned. EFAFA is a legal entity of its own under the Societies Act. They manage funds collected through AGLC-sanctioned events (such as the casino), and grants that the school boards may not apply for directly, in order to provide our children with technology, tools, and experiences to facilitate learning. At their AGM, members of EFAFA (those who have joined EFAFA as members by filling out a membership form) will elect their next executive team (President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer).

To ensure a larger number of voices at the table, and that legal, financial and operational separation is apparent to our school community, insurers, and regulatory authorities, it is imperative that the two groups' executive teams are as much as possible made up of different individuals.
