- Several items addressed via P2P; full report will be sent via swift to parents and posted to the website by the end of February.
- Items to be discussed in the meeting are:
 - Providing free / low-cost childcare at events (such as family dance).
 - Entire family is invited to attend family dance. May be difficult to provide additional childcare, especially for dance on Friday.
 - Can look into providing childcare for AGM with babysitting course trained grade 6 students.
 - Online communications request for hard copies / info package due to technology availability and / or missed emails.
 - Michelle discussed cost involved with hard copies in P2P
 - Paula majority of SWIFTs are email based. Texts are limited to 50 characters only so they are not sent as often. A text can indicate to families that an email was sent.
 - School attention to safety measures needed due to weather (with freezing rain, etc).
 - Mme. Borges-Couture school checks weather radio in the office regularly throughout the day.
 - School has administrative procedures with inclement weather (standardized across the division). Currently, when it is -20 and colder, students stay inside for indoor recess. Anything warmer, the students are outside. It is very important to make sure that they are bundled with appropriate clothing. Sometimes this can be overridden at lower temperatures based on wet weather, etc. for safety
 - SC created walk like a penguin signs
 - Salt is not allowed as per city policy
 - Mr. Nieford clears first thing in the morning near classroom doors.
 - High "melt areas" with lots of thawing then freezing are marked with pylons
 - Parent has offered to help with snow removal with personal bobcat
